INFANT & EARLY CHILDHOOD MENTAL HEALTH (IECMH) CONSULTANTS

IECMH Consultants provide specialized support by
providing consultation to the Prenatal to age six field in
the following ways:

Home/Classroom Focused

Collaborating with families and early childhood
staff to promote warm, trusting relationships,
steady routines, and development enhancing
interactions that positively impact classroom
and home climates.



Child and Family Specific

Collaborating with families and/or staff to
understand and respond to a child's or parent's
mental health needs, behavioral difficulties,
and/or developmental challenges



Programmatic

Systemic Approach that aims to have a program
wide impact, which focuses on equity and
inclusion, and social emotional climate issues
impacting multiple staff and children/ families



Who Should Consider Applying?

- Minimum of Bachelors Degree
- Previous Promising Minds Fellow OR individuals recommended by a Fellow or AIMH HI Staff
- Preference given to candidates with mental health education, training, and experience
- 3-5 years of work experience within the infant and early childhood sector
- Interest in providing IECMH consultation in the State of Hawai'i
